Course Duration : 6 Hours (WITH PRE COURSE HOME-WORK ACTIVITY)

Covered in this course are the following elements:

- Management of the Unconscious Casualty
- Basic Life Support - DRABCD
- Cardiopulmonary Resuscitation - Adult, Child & Infant
- Airway Obstruction / Asthma / Anaphylaxis
- Wounds & Bleeds management / Shock
- Communicate details of the incident
- Automated External Defibrillation - AED
- Legal Issues / Infection Control
- Heart Attack / Stroke
- Poisons , Bites & Stings
- Fractures, Dislocation, Sprain and Strain
- Spinal Injury / Head injury / Chest injury / Burns
- Diabetes / Epilepsy / Fainting / Drowning

Qualification

Certificate Validity

Safe Work Australia recommends that First Aid Qualifications are renewed every 3 years.

Safe Work Australia and the Australian Resuscitation Council recommend that CPR training be undertaken annually.

Entry Requirements

Participants must be 14 years or older. There are NO pre-requisites for this course however it is recommended that participants have sufficient literacy, language and numeracy skills to successfully complete the course and the capacity to perform CPR on the floor.
