### **Certificate Currency**

It is recommended by Worksafe Australia and other Peak bodies that First Aid Qualifications should be renewed every 3 years and that CPR refresher training be undertaken every 12 months

### **Entry Requirements**

There are no specific entry requirements, however Learners should have Literacy & Numeracy competencies equivalent to Australian Core skills Framework Level 1. This requires a candidate to be able to communicate incident details verbally and to be able to provide an accurate written or verbal report of the incident. Learners should be able to perform CPR on the floor & provide effective chest compressions
